CURBSIDE RECYCLING

Recycling must be sorted into two streams (paper and containers), put in blue bags, and placed to the curb on your recycling day one metre from your garbage cart.

PAPER PRODUCTS Newspaper, flyers, magazines, catalogues, envelopes, writing and computer paper (e.g. lined,

white, coloured), books (remove hardcover), boxboard (e.g. cereal, tissue, detergent boxes), egg cartons, paper bags, toilet and paper towel rolls, and corrugated cardboard.

CONTAINERS & PLASTICS

Aluminum (e.g. pop and beer cans, pie plates), plastic bottles (e.g. water, pop, liquor), plastic containers (e.g. ice cream, ketchup, bleach, shampoo, butter, sour cream, household cleaners, salad dressing, yogurt, baking trays, plastic fruit trays, plastic sandwich trays, etc.), tin cans (e.g. soup, coffee, tuna, cat food), gable tops (e.g. milk and juice cartons), and tetra paks (e.g. juice boxes, soup).

WHAT STAYS OUT

Glass, plastic bags/wrap, aerosol and paint cans, syringes, Styrofoam, diapers, kitty litter,

drink/coffee cups, gift wrapping paper, and toys (plastic, wood, metal).



Glass beverage containers are accepted at Green Depots.

A NOTE ON PLASTIC

You will find a recycling symbol with a number on the bottom of most containers. Plastic containers with the numbers 1-7 will be accepted in our curbside program. Plastic bags and Styrofoam are not accepted even if they have symbols/numbers on them.

Our program collects most containers for food, drink, and cleaning products.























BULK GARBAGE AND METAL COLLECTION

FREE PICKUPS

Households are permitted one free bulk garbage and one free metal collection during seasonal bulk collection per year. Residents must contact the Department of Public Works at 709-782-3577 to schedule these pickups.

NON-METAL ITEMS

Furniture, wood (4ft tied & bundled), vacuum cleaners, carpet, underlay, flooring, mattresses and box springs, Gyproc (broken down, boxed/bagged), toilets, vanity sinks, glass (boxed and marked GLASS), leaves (bagged), large and small wooden doors and large and small wooden windows.

METAL

Fridges, stoves, hot water boilers, deep freezers, dishwashers, metal tables and chairs, washers, dryers, swing sets (dismantled), bicycles, BBQs (no tanks), bathtubs, screen and metal doors, lawn mowers, and empty paint cans (lids off).

ITEMS WE DON'T PICK UP

Old electronics, propane tanks and cylinders, oil tanks, car parts, no motors of any kind, paints, car batteries, tires, chemical products, oils, hazardous waste materials, trees and stumps, earthen, brick or concrete materials, and home renovation/building materials.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Household hazardous waste is collected at the residential drop-off facility at Robin Hood Bay. It is open on Wednesdays and Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

PAINT RECYCLING PROGRAM

To recycle leftover paint, just take it to a product care collection site near you. Visit: www.regeneration.ca or call 1-877-592-2972.

USED TIRE RECYCLING PROGRAM

Residents can leave their used tires with a tire retailer upon the purchase of new tires, at no cost. They can also be returned to a retailer at a later date in manageable quantities (4-5 tires).

ELECTRONIC PRODUCTS RECYCLING PROGRAM

You can recycle your old/unwanted electronics by dropping them off at a designated centre near you. Visit www.recyclemyelectronics.ca/nl, or call 1-888-567-4535 to find a list of centres and items accepted.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is recycling picked up with garbage?

Recycling is collected bi-weekly in a separate truck from garbage. Both trucks look the same, however the recycling truck has compartments to separate paper and containers.

Why automated collection?

Automated collection is a safer, more efficient and cost-effective method of garbage collection. It increases fuel savings, and decreases accidents by improving employee safety. As well, there will be fewer litter, odour, and pest issues.

Who is responsible for the carts?

The carts are the property of the Town of Paradise. Each one is assigned to a dwelling, identified by a serial number that connects it to that property. If you move, the cart remains with the property. Residents are responsible for routine maintenance, including cleaning and safe storage. The carts have a 10-year warranty, and the Town takes care of warranty repairs.

The Town will replace carts as they reach the end of their lifecycle, however carts damaged by neglect, or stolen carts, will be replaced at the property owner's expense.

Where should the carts be stored?

Carts should be secured when removed from curbside to prevent damage from wind, snow or theft. Residents should store carts as close to their house as possible, and / or inside a garage or shed.

How do I get a cart if I move into an existing home?

A cart would have been assigned to that address, so it is recommended that you check on the condition of the cart at the time of the sale. If the cart is missing or needs to be repaired, you will be responsible for the replacement of the cart(s).











FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What if I am not physically able to move the cart to the curb?

The carts are equipped with large wheels to make it easy to roll to the curb. If you have a special circumstance, you can have your case reviewed upon written request to the Department of Public Works.

Can extra bags of garbage be placed at the curb for pick up? No. Carts that are overflowing or garbage that is placed outside of the carts will not be picked up.

Can I use my own cart, which looks identical to the town-supplied ones?

No. The town-supplied carts are embedded with a radio tag to help the Town manage cart inventory.

Do I need to bag my garbage inside the cart?

Yes. All garbage must be bagged up inside the carts to keep the cart clean and to avoid odour.

What kind of garbage can I place in the cart?

All regular household garbage may be placed inside the cart and must be bagged. Items that should not be placed inside the cart include: any recyclable material, dirt, sod, rocks, concrete, bricks, metal, flammable, toxic or hazardous materials, hot ashes or charcoal, construction materials, needles, solvents, animal carcasses, and electronics.

Where do I put the cart in winter?

During the winter do not place the cart on the road. Continue to place it at the end of your driveway and avoid placing near snowbanks.
